RESOLUTION NO. 2023-2

RESOLUTION OF THE MOORESVILLE REDEVELOPMENT COMMISSION APPROVING THE REIMBURSEMENT OF THE TOWN OF MOORESVILLE'S POLICE STATION PROJECT AND MATTERS RELATED THERETO

WHEREAS, the Town of Mooresville (the "Town") Redevelopment Commission (the "Commission"), as the governing body for the Town of Mooresville Redevelopment Department, previously adopted (and subsequently confirmed and amended) a Declaratory Resolution that established and amended an economic development area known as the Consolidated Mooresville Economic Development Area (the "Economic Development Area"), designated a portion of the Economic Development Area as an "allocation area" pursuant to IC 36-7-14-39 known as the Consolidated Mooresville Economic Development Area Allocation Area (the "Consolidated Allocation Area"), and approved a development plan for the Economic Development Area (the "Consolidated Economic Development Plan"); and

WHEREAS, the Consolidated Economic Development Plan permits tax increment revenues from the Consolidated Allocation Area (the "TIF Revenues") in an amount not to exceed \$175,000 to be used to finance all or a portion of the costs of acquiring, constructing and installing a fence at the police station, a rough in for future expansion of the existing police station, and all incidental expenses incurred in connection therewith (the "Police Station Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Commission desires to reimburse the Town for the costs of the Police Station Project up to \$175,000 from the TIF Revenues;

Now, Therefore, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town of Mooresville Redevelopment Commission, as follows:

- 1. Upon the Town's completion of the Police Station Project, the Commission agrees to reimburse the Town for the costs of the Police Station Project up to \$175,000 out of TIF Revenues.
 - 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
