The Mooresville Town Council met in regular session on Tuesday, April 1, 2025, at 6:30 PM at the Mooresville Government Center.

Council members present were Council President Warthen, Councilman Swinney, Councilman Cook, Councilman Brown, and Councilman Witt. Town Attorney Chou-il Lee was also present.

Council President Warthen gave the invocation and called the meeting to order.

Councilman Brown motioned to approve the April 1, 2025, meeting minutes, seconded by Councilman Cook. Motion carried 5-0.

Unfinished Business:

There were none.

New Business:

The Morgan County Mental Health Task Force was initially scheduled on today's agenda; however, they have withdrawn their request to appear and will reschedule once the proclamation has been provided.

The Vertical Bridge agreement was presented to the Town Council, and Town Attorney Chou-il Lee noted that it requires additional review before any final action can be taken.

Consultant Chelsie Manns of the Mooresville Redevelopment Commission presented the April 15th Report, which provides a snapshot of the RDC 2024 activities. This report must be submitted to the designated State database for compliance reporting.

Department Head Reports:

Chief of Police Buckner said he would provide a tornado siren maintenance agreement for review at the next council meeting.

Fire Chief Dalton reported that, of the two individuals given conditional offers, one began employment but left after three days to accept a position in another town. He is currently considering the potential hiring of a part-time firefighter.

Approval of Claims:

Councilman Swinney motioned to approve claims of \$2,591,657.90, seconded by Councilman Brown. Motion carried 5-0.

Approval of Payroll Clearing:


Councilman Swinney motioned to approve claims of \$243,079.12, seconded by Councilman Brown. Motion carried 5-0.
