

team members are exempt from some of the policies. Attorney Braun stated that it must list what the exemptions are for the SWAT team members.

Attorney Braun stated that the next SOP 30.02, Department Fire Qualifications, was what he wanted to discuss. There was a small amount of discussion.

Attorney Braun stated that he would then like to discuss SOP 30.00 next. He pointed out a few typos in the document and grammar errors. Attorney Braun went page by page over the document regarding the changes that he would like to see made. There was minor discussion.

Attorney Braun stated that the next policy was 30.05, Destroying animals. Attorney Braun asked if there was more than one page to the policy. Chief Julian stated that there was not. Attorney Braun stated that the policy needed to be updated to show page 1 of 1.

Attorney Braun stated that the next policy was 30.04, Discharging Firearms. There was discussion about this policy amongst the Commissioners, Chief and the attorney. Chief Julian explained what the Major Crimes Task Force was and when they were utilized.

Attorney Braun stated that the last policy of the night to discuss was 30.01, Patrol Rifle. There were a few grammar changes that needed to be made.

Chief Julian presented the Police Commission with SOP 30.02 as written and approved by Attorney Charles Braun. Commissioner Wilson made a motion accept the SOP and Commissioner Settle seconded. No discussion at this time. Motion passed unanimously.

Chief Julian presented the Police Commission with SOP 30.01 as written with the grammar errors to be corrected before publication and approved by Attorney Charles Braun. Commissioner Wilson made a motion accept the SOP and Commissioner Settle seconded. No discussion at this time. Motion passed unanimously.

There was no old business from the Commission Attorney.

Chief Julian presented the Police Commission with the stats from December 2020 and the entire year of 2020.

Chief Julian stated that he would like the Police Commission to review SOP 9.01, Vehicle Maintenance. Chief Julian stated that he spoke with Tom Duh, Representative with Big O Tires, regarding the mileage for oil changes in the vehicles. Chief Julian stated that the number was increased from 3,000 miles to 5,000 miles. Chief Julian stated that this was the only change that he made and he did fix the grammar errors. The Police Commission stated that they would like to review the policy. Attorney Braun stated that there was a section on page 2 that he believed was already covered in another policy, regarding the actions of passengers in the police vehicle.

Chief Julian stated that he would like to update the Police Officer's Bill of Rights. Chief Julian pointed out that Captain Kays had spoken with Attorney Braun last year when the internal investigation was going on. Chief Julian stated that he would like for Attorney Braun to either

draft a new Bill of Rights or to make changes to the current one with the Police Commissions permission. Chief Julian stated that there would be some changes that would also need to be made to some policies once the Bill of Rights was finished. Attorney Braun stated that creating a new document is not included in his yearly fee and named what he would charge per hour. Chief Julian stated that he would prefer the document be made by someone who knew the law. Commissioner Wilson made a motion for Attorney Braun to draft the document and to accept his cost. Commissioner Settle seconded the motion. No discussion at this time. Motion passed unanimously.

Chief Julian updated the Police Commission on the status of the hiring process.

Chief Julian advised that the Town of Mooresville added a new Holiday, Freedom Day (June 19th). It is currently a recognized State of Indiana holiday and that town has adopted it as well.

Chief Julian advised that Probationary Officers Miller and Turner have been released from training and are working on their own.

Commissioner Wilson made a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Settle seconded. No discussion and motion passed unanimously.
