8. DEPARTMENT REPORTS

8.1 Assistant Superintendent Report

8.1.1 RECU is back in session after the holidays, with 358 students enrolled—30 more than last year.

8.1.2 The Sweetheart Dance is on Saturday, February 7, from 6:30 to 8:00 p.m. at Neil Armstrong Elementary.

8.1.3 RD Productions will release the concert schedule soon. Please note that all concerts will be held at Pioneer Park because of the upcoming construction project on Main Street.

8.1.4 Registration for shelters and our winter/spring programming opened on January 5, 2026.

8.2 Superintendent Report

8.2.1 Pioneer Park Project is still on track to finish the project by May.



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- 8.2.2 The Town Council has agreed to purchase the land for \$195,000, but will use the allocated amount in the Food and Beverage to fund the project out of the 2026 allocated funds.
- 8.2.3 We have officially received the State Release for the new barn construction and are working on finalizing the local town release to begin construction. Once we have the local release, we will start construction immediately.
- 8.2.4 Buddenbaum has begun work on the Family Aquatic Center Project. They have excavated the concrete deck around the deep end and along the deck drain. This project will mainly be funded through the food and beverage fund, which has \$176,000. The remaining amount of \$16,890 will come from our non-recurring program fund. The Town Council approved this plan in their meeting on October 7, 2025..
- 8.2.5 Trails Health Department Grant: We are currently awaiting the final grant agreement from the Indiana Department of Health (IDOH). Once we receive this agreement, we will meet with the IDOH representative to discuss the scope of work, the project schedule, the consultant selection process, and the invoice procedures related to the grant.
- 8.2.6 FEMA – Pool Claim: We have worked with FEMA representatives over the holiday break, and regrettably, we have received our FEMA determination notice of claim rejection.
- 8.2.7 We are working with EXOS to fix some broadband signal problems in the park. Until these issues are resolved, please do not change the camera signals or settings. Once we fix the problems, we will work with Koorsen to adjust the settings and add any new cameras.




11. BOARD MEMBER'S COMMENTS
