8. DEPARTMENT REPORTS

8.1 Assistant Superintendent Report

8.1.1 RECU will be closed for Winter Break from December 19 and will resume on January 5. Winter Break Camp at Neil Armstrong will take place on Dec 22, 23, 29, and 30.

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8.2 Superintendent Report

- 8.2.1 Pioneer Park Project – BOT Disbursement #5. Current disbursement total: \$433,461.59 for completed project milestones (documentation included). The RDC voted on Thursday evening to pay, bringing our total project costs spent to date to \$2,790,458.89
- 8.2.2 The Town Council has agreed to purchase the land for \$195,000 but will use the allocated amount in the Food and Beverage to fund the project.
- 8.2.3 The barn has been successfully deconstructed and relocated to the Park. We are now waiting on the final State building permit to reconstruct the structure, which we should receive comments back by the end of next week.
- 8.2.4 Waiting on Buddenbaum to start the Family Aquatic Center Project , which could begin 12/09.
- 8.2.5 Mooresville Parks and Recreation was granted the Trails Health Department Grant.
- 8.2.6 Working with FEMA and have provided all required paperwork to date for the Pool claim
- 8.2.7 Hard copies for the Master Plan are being placed in the mail by Troyer Group.
